

REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING

The Clay Banks Town Board met on Monday, May 9th at the town hall. Chairman Johnson called the meeting to order at 6:00PM. Officers present were Johnson, Heimbecher, Olson, Kolstad and Bongle. Heimbecher made a motion to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Olson. Motion carried.

Public Comments & Suggestions: None.

Olson made a motion to approve the minutes of April 19th as read, seconded by Heimbecher. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Cash accounts totaled \$140,288.10, CD's totaled \$100,361.67, for a grand total of \$240,649.77.

Communications: All correspondence was presented.

Committee Reports: None.

Old Business:

A. American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds. Clerk Bongle reported she filed the report due April 30, 2022.

B. Broadband. Chairman Johnson reported on what has transpired since the last Broadband Committee meeting. A general discussion took place on a town survey, sponsored by the Door County Economic Development Corporation.

C. Invasive Species Control in Township. Clerk Bongle reported she has not received an email for Door County Soil & Water to date. She will report at next month's meeting.

New Business:

A. Commercial Building & Electrical Inspections in the Town. Heimbecher made a motion to approve the adoption of the DSPS code 316 as presented, seconded by Olson. Motion carried.

B. Increased costs impacting budgets. Chairman Johnson reported on the increase in cost of blacktop per mile; our budget cannot absorb the increase in cost. The board will have to look at ways to continue to fund our road improvements.

C. Election Security.gov Email Domain. Clerk Bongle gave a brief description of the request from the Wisconsin Elections Commission for the town to have a .gov email and website domain. She will research some options and present them at the June meeting.

Roads:

A. Road Survey. It was a consensus to discuss this further at the June meeting.

B. Road Maintenance and Repair. Nothing at this time.

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Bills: Bills in the amount of \$7,745.62 were presented for payment. Chairman Johnson made a motion to approve the payment of bills as presented seconded by Heimbecher. Motion carried.

Adjourn: A motion was made by Heimbecher to adjourn at 6:35PM, seconded by Olson. Motion carried.
